Private collectors and trade buyers from the U.S., Asia, and South America were the most active of our registered bidders, yielding strong sell-through rates of 87% by lot and 89% by value. Classic wines in every category sold well, and the top lots included a case of 1990 Château Pétrus, 10 bottles of 1990 La Tâche, and 11 bottles of 1982 Pétrus. Of special note is the successful charity auction of a rare bottle of 1865 Marquis de Montesquiou Armagnac. Proceeds from the sale of this lot, which achieved \$8,400, will be generously donated to GoodPlanet, a non-profit organization dedicated to raising public awareness of environmental protection.”
