“Christie's *Impressionist and Modern Art Day Sale* completely harmonized with the trends seen in yesterday's evening sale. The top lot of today was the bronze sculpture *La Joconde* by René Magritte which set a new world auction record for a sculpture by the artist at \$2.28 million, almost eight times as much as the previous Magritte sculpture record. Sculpture fared well throughout the sale, as did works by Modernists, in particular Surrealists such as Max Ernst and de Chirico,” said Sharon Kim, Head of Impressionist and Modern Art Day Sale.

Christie's sales of Impressionist and Modern Art totaled \$282,441,400 this week.
