Pablo Picasso (1881-1973) spent the last 20 years of his life working partly in his ceramics studio on the Mediterranean coast of France. During that time, he produced 633 different ceramic designs which were then made available in limited editions, so that anybody could afford to buy them. The same is true today, and the sale will suit many pockets, as Picasso would have intended, with estimates starting at £300. However, for those with deeper pockets, it's possible to pick up a unique Picasso Ceramic, hand-painted by Picasso himself with a pre-sale estimate of £40,000.
