NEW YORK – On May 11, Christie's will offer Alberto Giacometti's *Femme debout* (estimate: \$2,800,000-3,500,000) and Julio González's *Danseuse à la palette* (estimate: \$600,000-800,000) in its newly-formatted 20th Century Evening Sale in New York.

The works will be exhibited at Christie's Hong Kong from April 17-22 alongside Mark Rothko's [*Untitled*](#) (Estimate on request).

Together, Alberto Giacometti's *Femme debout* and Julio González's *Danseuse à la palette* demonstrate the compelling diversity of twentieth-century sculpture. Presenting the human figure in two radically different ways, these works stand as defining examples of these respective artists' practices.

Conceived circa 1952, Giacometti's *Femme debout* is one of the artist's signature elongated figures. Unlike their male counterparts, Giacometti's women appear as hieratic, motionless bodies, their expressions inscrutable and impassive. This work, which has remained in the same private collection for close to three decades, encapsulates the compelling power and multivalent iconography of these female figures.

Filled with an impressive dynamism rendered from a striking economy of means, *Danseuse à la palette* is one of González's revolutionary linear metal sculptures. Conceived *circa* 1934, this work dates from a period of prolific invention during which the artist united his unique skill at metalwork with a novel artistic vision. Other casts of the present work are in the collections of the Galleria Nazionale d'Arte Moderna, Rome and the Centre Georges Pompidou, Paris.
