Noteworthy individual results include the pair of fine Louis XIV style 'Boulle' commodes by Blake of London which sold to a private US collector for \$577,000; 'Grande Horloge', a monumental pedestal clock, by Maison Millet, which brought \$385,000; and François Linke's 'Régulateur Louis XV Surmonté du Motif le Temps', which realized \$241,000."
