Carina Villinger, Head of 20th Century Decorative Arts, Christie's Americas, remarked: "The sales saw excellent prices for the works that Alberto Giacometti executed for Jean-Michel Frank, and especially for the lamps, which all far exceeded their high estimates. Most notable was A pair of 'Calabash' table lamps, which realized \$530,500 against its presale estimate of \$40,000-60,000. These sales conclude three days of 20th century decorative arts sales in New York, including the Collection of Steven A. Greenberg, bringing the week's combined total to \$23,224,687."
