Per Holmberg, Head of Wine at Christie's, North America, said: "These two sales achieved \$3.6 million, marking a major high point in the Wine spring season for New York. We were honored to have offered private collections of wines that rarely, if ever, become available on the market. *Treasures From a Swiss Connoisseur Part II* was 99% sold by lot and value, with top prices achieved for classic Bordeaux and DRC. *Cellar Selections of Vega-Sicilia*, one of the most comprehensive collections of pre-war Unico, sold double the low estimate and was highlighted by the very rare bottle of White Unico 1938, realizing \$7,963, eight times its estimate. Overall, we saw broad participation from clients, especially from Asia, and a renewed interest in first growths from 1982."
