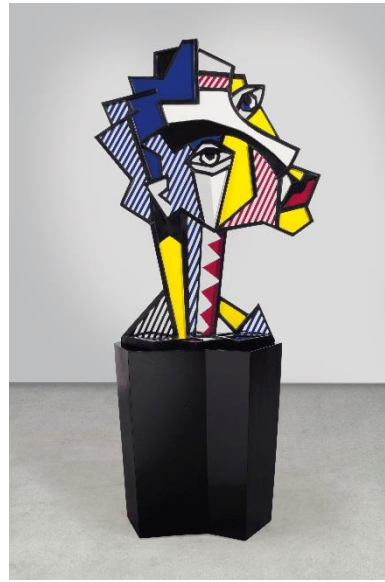

**New York** – Christie's is honored to announce ***Property from Cleveland Clinic generously donated by Mrs. Sydell Miller*** will be offered during 20<sup>th</sup> Century Week in May 2017, with all proceeds benefiting Cleveland Clinic Heart & Vascular Institute. This collection will include a selection of eight Impressionist, Modern, Post-War, and Contemporary artworks including Pablo Picasso's *Femme assise dans un fauteuil* (estimate: \$20-30 million) and Roy Lichtenstein's *Expressionist Head* (estimate: \$2.5-3.5 million). A global tour of highlights from the collection will start in February at Christie's London prior to the New York sale. More details of the collection and global tour will be announced in February 2017.
