Hong Kong – On 2 October, 2017, Christie's Hong Kong will once again host the highly anticipated Pavilion Sale, which will include a small group of Japanese works of art for the first time since the sale's inception.

The curated sale of over 220 lots focuses on works with exceptional provenance from several private collections including Tang to Song ceramics from the Mengdiexuan Collection, cosmetic boxes from the Dexinshuwu Collection, Chinese art from the Yangdetang Collection and a selection of archaic jades from a private Hong Kong collection.

Chi Fan Tsang, Senior Vice President, Specialist Head of Department, commented, “The inclusion of Japanese works of art this season wonderfully compliments the diverse collection of Chinese works of art being offered, demonstrating the growing demand and appreciation for art across different cultures. With estimates from HKD 15,000 to HKD1,500,000, the sale once again provides an accessible platform for collectors to incorporate these attractive pieces into a contemporary and cultured lifestyle”.
