FOR A GOLD REF. 4261**

New York – Christie's New York June 6 auction *An Evening of Exceptional Watches* achieved a total of **\$5,861,125** with 80% sold by lot. The top lot of the sale was a **Patek Philippe reference 3448 in white gold with bracelet**, which sold for **\$1,155,000**, establishing the world auction record for the regular production of this reference at auction.

Other notable results included a **Vacheron Constantin reference 4261 in 18k gold**, which sold for **\$356,250**, setting the world auction record for a ref. 4261 in gold; a very rare **Rolex Daytona with "Paul Newman" dial, retailed by Linz Brothers, Dallas, 1968** that realized **\$312,500**; and a **Patek Philippe reference 1463 stainless steel chronograph wristwatch with bracelet, retailed by Gübelin**, that realized **\$423,000**.

The *Christie's Watches Online: Travel with Time Sale* continues through June 25 and presents 236 watches ranging from vintage to contemporary timepieces.
